2019 - England, Wales and Scotland

The Rocky Mountaineers are headed to England, Wales and Scotland in August/September 2019. We will be visiting London, Cotswolds, Snowdonia, Lake District, York and Edinburgh. We'll even stop by Stonehenge (not to confused with Nebraska's Carhenge) for a photo opportunity.

We have room for 42 passengers, and if we can fill the bus (like we did in Ireland in 2015 and on our Italy/Switzerland/Austria/Germany trip in 2016) we will have an exclusive trip for our group. We know this trip seems way in the future, but we need to plan ahead for those of you with busy schedules.

- Make the \$350 per person deposit that is <u>fully refundable</u> (pay in cash for the discount).

We expect the costs to be approximately the same as the 2018 prices, which are \$4,700 per person, including air from Denver. If you pay in full 15 months before our departure date (no credit cards), you will receive a 10% discount. In addition, the Rocky Mountaineers will give you an another 10% discount at the end of the trip. You won't find a better deal anywhere else!!

The 3-night London pre-trip extension would be approximately \$700 PP and the 4-night Scottish Highlands post-trip would be approximately \$1,100.

The actual trip dates and prices are expected to be released in April 2018. Once we select the trip dates, you'll have 14 days to decide if you want to apply your pre-registration to the trip.
