Japan's Cultural Treasures March 25 - April 8, 2024

The Rocky Mountaineers are traveling to Japan in the spring of 2024. We will explore Japan's Cultural Treasures with Overseas Adventure Travel (OAT) during the 2024 cherry blossom season. The main trip departs the US on March 25 and returns on April 8, 2024.

Trip accommodations include 3 nights in Tokyo, 2 nights in Hakone, 3 nights in Kanazawa, and 5 nights in Kyoto. All breakfasts, 9 lunches, and 7 dinners are included. The base price is **\$5,095** per person. Air transportation (from Denver) is available for **\$1,900** per person (prices vary based on departure city). There's even a direct Denver to Tokyo flight. A 3-night Tokyo pretrip extension is available for \$995 per person. Travel insurance is also available through OAT.

This is an exclusive trip with space limited to a maximum of 16 travelers. We have 14 travelers so far with two spaces remaining. A 10% rebate will be provided at the time of travel assuming we have 11 or more travelers.

- 4. Make the \$350 per person deposit by check or credit card.

Noteworthy:

- Luggage porters are generally not available at hotels and on trains.
- An overnight travel bag is recommended for Days 5 and 6 in Hokone the larger luggage will be sent ahead to Kanazawa.
- Day 7 includes riding a bullet train, traveling up to 200 MPH.
- Day 13 includes an uphill walk with 200 steps to reach Senkoji Temple (participation is optional).
