

Ancient Egypt & the Nile River November 12-27, 2026

The Rocky Mountaineers will be traveling with Overseas Adventure Travel (OAT) on their *Ancient Egypt & the Nile River* in the fall of 2026. The base trip departs the US on November 12 and returns on November 27, 2026.

Trip accommodations include: seven nights in Cairo and 7 nights on the Nile River aboard the 75-passenger Nefertiti. All 14 breakfasts, 11 lunches, and 10 dinners are included. Per person prices are:

- \$6,395 for Ship Cabin Category A – Akhenaten Deck (Upper Deck)
- \$6,195 for Ship Cabin Category B – Meritaten Deck (Middle Deck)
- \$5,995 for Ship Cabin Category C – Tutankhamun Deck (Lower Deck)
- \$1,650 for economy cabin air transportation from Denver (price varies from other cities)
- Early payment discount of up to 6% is available when paying by ACH or check
- A group rebate of approximately 10% will be disbursed to travelers after the trip if we have 11 or more travelers in our group.

To register:

- Call OAT Registration at **1-800-597-2452**
- Tell the representative you want to register for the **Ancient Egypt & the Nile River departing November 12, 2026.**
- Tell the representative you are with the **Rocky Mountaineers, group booking code G6-22528**
- Ask if any special discounts are available.
- Let the representative know if you want to include air transportation (you will be responsible for your transportation between the airport and hotel/ship if you provide your own air).
- Deposit \$750 per person (recommend paying with ACH to maximize your discount if you plan to pay in full early). GCT recently changed their cancellation policy; they now charge \$750 to cancel river boat reservations 90 days or more in advance (deposits and other payments can be moved to different trips).
- GCT will recommend purchasing their Travel Protection Plan (some travel insurance is required, although less expensive plans may be available through InsureMyTrip.com or other third parties).
